

Dear Friends of the Sterling Volunteer Rescue Squad:

We are excited to report that through your generous donations over the past few years the Sterling Volunteer Rescue Squad has continued to meet the needs of the community in providing quality, world class, emergency medical support to Sterling, Ashburn, and the surrounding communities. Thank you for your continued support!

Looking back at the past year, we added an Advanced Life Support (ALS) transport unit to our inventory (bringing our fleet to nine ALS equipped ambulances) and have been able to replace several aging support vehicles (to include the procurement of a 2022 Ford F350 4-wheel drive utility vehicle, designated as "Utility 625"). In addition, we (with support from Loudoun County) are nearing completion of our new, modern fire/rescue facility in Sterling Park that will serve the community well into the future.

In early 2022, Sterling Rescue created an internal program to increase our ranks of certified paramedics by instituting a tuition assistance program to allow volunteer personnel the opportunity to attend courses leading to a National-level paramedic certification. In addition, utilizing Loudoun County Combined Fire and Rescue (LC-CFRS) training resources, Sterling Rescue graduated 15 EMTs, 4 Advanced EMTs, and 1 Paramedic, who are now providing critical EMS support to the community.

This past year has certainly kept us busy. During 2022, we saw a 10% increase in 911 call volume, with Sterling Rescue responding to over 8900 calls for assistance in

the community. Our highly trained volunteers continue to work with LC-CFRS to respond to calls for assistance, to supporting numerous community events, and providing educational opportunities to the community. Our goal, as it has been for the past 59 years, is to help make Sterling, Ashburn, and the surrounding areas a safer community.

As call volume and requests for support increase, Sterling Rescue continues to solicit your assistance. We are continuing our efforts to recruit new volunteer members with the drive (and the time) to help us serve the community. We continue to look for volunteers to grow our operational membership (as EMTs, AEMTs, and Paramedics) as well as our administrative membership to assist with the day-to-day business operations of the organization.
